Beschreibung	<p>Let's experience English in a different and new environment - and let's focus on actually using English for conversational purposes.</p> <p>Maybe you are afraid to speak English, concerned to make mistakes and be judged for them? These are often problems when learning a language in school without a real reason to actually use it outside of the classroom.</p> <p>In this class, I want you to experience English as a language for communication. We will explore different kinds of topics through different kinds of authentic media (different texts, movies, series, music, podcasts, ...). This input will build the basis for many possibilities to use spoken English in various ways. Next to traditional approaches like discussions and conversations, there can be creative ways to get involved: role plays, interviews, creating own podcasts or audiobooks or even short videos - as long as you end up speaking.</p> <p>Since I want you to participate actively, you will have a say in many decisions and can therefore help leading the direction of the class.</p> <p>And hopefully, you will eventually find out that often it does not really matter if your grammar is perfect but rather if you can make yourself understood.</p>
